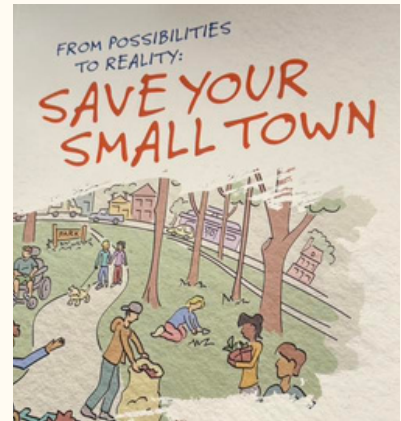
Our monthly community meetings continue to run strong and we are all better for the relationships we have created and the projects that have been accomplished.
